2. Be sure your child has a health insurance card and is aware of plan if gets sick college health center, nearby doctor, or urgent care (NOT free standing ER due to over charges), as well as closest hospital if emergency.
_3. Pack ALL the things in the large plastic bins. IF YOUR CHILD IS GOING FAR AWAY FOR COLLEGE, consider online shopping with pick-up in college town.
4. Prep a move-in day tool box or bag (command hooks, scissors, tape, sticky tack, tacks, hammer and nails if allowed, allen wrench, screwdriver, extra extension cords, etc whatever might be needed!)
5. Pack snacks and water bottles for move-in, and possibly card games for other children who may need to be occupied as you help move-in.
6. Gas up cars and load the night before.
7. Don't forget your letter for your child and care package to leave, if you planned for this.
8. Give your child cash and be clear on budget and spending needs and habits before move-in day.
_9. Have a great family meal together the night before move-in and keep the mood light. Then, get good sleep.
10. Remember your move-in plan, stick to it as you can or be flexible as required. Be prepared for Walmart run in college town AND big crowds there.
11. Take deep breaths, cheer your child on, and keep the goodbye quick.
